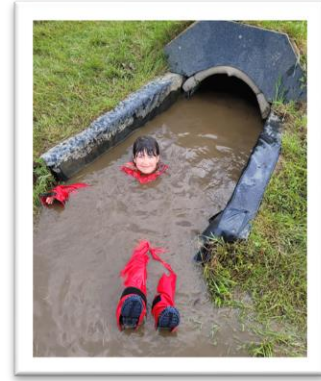

Welsh Language

Ysgol Gymraeg Trelyn provides a bilingual education for all who wish, and the ability to speak Welsh at home is not a pre-requisite to being accepted at our school. We encourage children to use the Welsh language as early as possible within the school. We ensure that the children are aware that the language meets the needs of a contemporary society.

Welsh is the main language used throughout the school, but English is introduced as a subject in Year 3. Our aim is to ensure that the children are fluent and confident in both languages.

We kindly ask parents to take advantage of every opportunity for children to have experiences through the medium of Welsh i.e. through attending any clubs and extra-curricular activities.

All correspondence between school and parents is made through both Welsh and English.

Children are expected to speak Welsh during the school day and are encouraged to do so from an early age. Welsh is also used to communicate during break times and lunch times. Children are rewarded for using the Welsh language.

If children refuse to speak Welsh, this not only breaks one of our school rules, but also goes against our school ethos. In such instances, the staff will hold discussions with the child and if no progress is made, parents will be invited to school to discuss this with the Headteacher.

Staff Development

Performance Management is the term used to describe the process of agreeing annual performance targets involving discussions between teachers and their team leaders and Headteacher's and the Governing Body.

Performance management supports the work of teachers as individuals and in teams. It establishes a framework for teachers and their team leaders to agree and review priorities and objectives in the context of the school's development plan. It motivates staff to be more effective

Progress Report

Develop staff confidence and pupils' skills in the expressive arts by sharing the school's best practices to raise standards further

Under the guidance of the county's Music Services, we have provided instrumental lessons of the highest standard to 100% of Yr 3 - Yr 6 learners including ukulele lessons from Yr 4 - Yr 6 and singing lessons for Yr 3 learners. The instrumental lessons will continue next year.

Yr 5 and 6 learners have worked with the WNO throughout the year and the recent performance at the Cardiff Millennium Center was evidence of the success of the project. We are extremely pleased that the project is continuing for 2024 - 2025. In addition to that, Year 6 attended a BBC orchestra concert. All of this has, without doubt, raised the status of music for almost all Year 3 - Year 6 learners.

Rhodri Harris, Creative Practitioner, came to the school to work with Year 1 and Year 2 learners who managed to compose a song with him.

Charanga was also introduced to the staff and we hope to see an increase in the use of this resource in the classrooms.

We had an Expressive Arts in-service training day during the summer term with all school staff developing art and music skills specifically. The feedback shows that almost all members of staff benefitted from the day and feel that they have improved their skills. In addition to this, the five elements of the AoLE began to be intertwined in order to ensure appropriate attention to art, dance, drama, music, film and the digital media.

We have held art clubs after school for Year 1 - Year 6 learners and as a result the learners have developed a wide range of skills including creating mosaic work for the Urdd Eisteddfod competition.

During the next year, we will continue to share good practice in this area of learning to ensure that we benefit from the good practice available in Trelyn.

We will also ensure that we continue to include enough singing opportunities especially in CC3

We have also earmarked Garage Band, Purple Mash and Chrome Music Lab training with the county's Music Services for 2024/2025.

Enrich the learning environment across the whole school

We have dedicated and clear areas in the external area and in the provision in our CC1 and CC2 classes. There are also suitable resources in the areas to enrich the learning. There is regular use of the areas by CC1 and 2 learners with most learners working independently in them. There is purposeful use of the forest area which is now an ideal place for outdoor lessons. Mr James has attended the forest schools training and we will develop this further during the next year and hold a forest schools club for some of the Year 6 children.

Almost every class looks appealing and displays purposeful work.

Clear planning occurs when planning appropriate activities in the ongoing areas.

The assistants play an interactive role in planning for the areas and feel ownership over them

We will continue to develop purposeful and independent activities to promote independence.

We will also plan a timetable for planting the flowers/vegetables including one for the parents' association.

Refine and improve the school's self improvement systems (assessment, tracking and professional development)

The @teb system has been adopted by the school and we have held successful INSET days to evaluate the school's self-evaluation systems.

Staff have taken ownership of the SDP targets and are constantly evaluating progress.

The use of FADE systems has enabled staff to highlight target groups according to the data collected from the first assessment cycle. The effect of this was that the school's internal monitoring systems ensure that our processes are more meaningful and purposeful. By using FADE sheets there is consistency in the way staff evaluate data and set the way forward.

Monitoring plans and books shows that there is clear progress in the learners' literacy work.

Reconciling the plans has ensured that the distinction is clear in the books and opportunities to evaluate the lessons learned on a weekly basis.

The use of a Google Forms questionnaire has helped to refine plans and reduce burden (e.g. week-end evaluations).

An effective triad cycle has been held across the school with a focus on sharing practices on developing independent learners and developing the learner's voice in our lessons.

Monitoring plans and numeracy books has highlighted good practices and general areas of development across the school (developing challenges for the Pentagon group and setting more opportunities for self-assessment against the learning pit and self-evaluation of work.)
