



Polisi Gwisg Ysgol / School Uniform Policy

Polisi Ysgol Gymraeg Trelyn yw bod pob plentyn yn gwisgo gwisg ysgol wrth fynychu'r ysgol neu wrth fynychu digwyddiadau ble mae'r plentyn yn cynrychioli'r ysgol y tu allan i oriau arferol yr ysgol.

Mae'r polisi gwisg ysgol yn rhan o ymroddiad yr ysgol tuag at gyfle cyfartal a chynhwysiad. Mae Corff Llywodraethol yr ysgol yn credu fod gwisg ysgol yn galluogi i holl ddisgyblion yr ysgol rannu ymdeimlad o hunaniaeth gan ddathlu nodweddion sydd yn gyffredin i bawb, gan hefyd barchu amrywiaeth.

Er mwyn bod yn gyfforddus gall y plant wisgo trwser loncian goch.

ESGIDIAU

Mae'n bwysig bod eich plentyn yn gwisgo esgidiau priodol i'r ysgol yn ddyddiol. Mae esgidiau ysgafn neu esgidiau â sodlau uchel yn gallu gwneud niwed i'w traed, ac yn gallu achosi damweiniau. Gofynnwn i ddisgyblion wisgo esgidiau du; serch hynny, byddwn yn derbyn treinyrs os ydynt yn hollol ddu a heb unrhyw logos lliwgar arnynt.

STEIL GWALLT EITHAFOL

POLISI GWISGO GEMWAITH

Mae llywodraethwyr yr ysgol wedi cytuno nad yw'n briodol blant wisgo gemwaith yn yr ysgol. Caniateir i blant wisgo oriawr a styd fel clustlws. Ni chaniateir i blant wisgo unrhyw fath arall o glustlws, modrwyon,

mwclis nag addurn ar yr arddwrn. Rhaid sicrhau hefyd bod clustlysau yn cael eu tynnu allan neu eu gorchuddio yn ystod gwersi ymarfer corff.

Enwau ar ddillad / dillad coll

Rydym yn annog y rhieni, gofalwyr a phlant i sicrhau fod pob dilledyn wedi ei labelu yn glir gydag enw'r plentyn. Mae hyn yn cynnwys esgidiau addysg gorfforol. Polisi Gwisg Ysgol / School Uniform Policy

It is school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours.

The policy for school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school;*
- creates a sense of community and belonging towards the school;*
- is practical and smart;*
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;*
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and is considered by parents/carers as good value for money.*

The school uniform policy is an integral part of the school's commitment to equality and inclusion. The governing body believes the school uniform policy allows all pupils to establish a shared identity and celebrate what they have in common, whilst respecting diversity.

If in doubt, please check with the school office before purchasing items for wear in school.

Our school uniform is as follows:

FORMAL UNIFORM

- Black or grey trousers*
- Grey skirt*
- Red jumper with school logo*
- White or red polo shirt*
- Black shoes*

SUMMER UNIFORM

- Red gingham dress*
- Grey tailored shorts#*

TRACKSUITS

For comfort, the children may wear red track suit bottoms to school.

FOOTWEAR

It is important that your child wears suitable shoes to school on a daily basis – light shoes and those with high heels can harm your child's feet, and be the cause of accidents. Shoes must be safe and sensible for playground and indoor use. No narrow or raised heels are allowed. The preferable option is black shoes for all pupils. However we will allow trainers as long as they are completely black and do not have any colourful logos.

EXTREME HAIRCUTS

The school does not permit children to have extreme haircuts or hair colour. When required, unusual hairstyles will be discussed with parents.

JEWELLERY

The School Governors have agreed that it is not appropriate to wear jewellery at school. Pupils will be allowed to wear a watch and stud earrings. Pupils will not be allowed to wear any other type of earrings, necklaces or bracelets. During PE lessons pupils will need to remove their stud earrings or cover them up.

NAMING OF ITEMS AND LOST PROPERTY

Please make sure that the inside of all your child's clothes are clearly marked with the child's name. Shoes should also have names written inside. The school will endeavour to reunite lost named items with their owners. Unnamed lost property will be disposed of at the end of term or recycled.

First names or full names should not be embroidered on school uniform for safety and safeguarding reasons. It is however acceptable for initials to be embroidered on uniform.
